The NHPHP is a confidential program that can help to establish supports for those with professional burnout, substance misuse, behavioral, or other mental health concerns impacting your work and well being. The program covers 13 licensing boards including medicine, dentistry, nursing, psychology, dieticians, midwifery, optometry, chiropractic, podiatry, veterinarians, and others.

NHPHP accepts referrals from any source including self-referral, peers, colleagues, hospitals, practice managers, medical staffs, office staffs, regulatory agencies, licensing boards, attorneys, treatment centers, family and friends.

### **NHPIP Update**

See the newly updated NH Pediatric Behavioral Health Referral Directory

This month the NHPIP released an updated version of its <a href="NH Pediatric Behavioral">NH Pediatric Behavioral</a>
Health Referral Directory. The Directory contains updated information about local pediatric behavioral health resources including organization name, address, phone number, website, Medicaid acceptance, types of services, language assistance and telehealth offerings. Providers can either use the searchable on-line directory or download a PDF version of it. Given enhancements made to the NH Rapid Response system and the launch of the national 988 suicide crisis line, a new resource page outlining crisis services in NH is also available.

The Directory is supported by a grant awarded to the NH Department of Health and Human Services by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA).

### Maternal-Infant Health and Opioid Use (MIHOU) Round Table Discussions Series
